A SMART goal is clear and well-defined (Specific), has concrete criteria for measuring progress (Measurable), is within reach given your resources and constraints (Achievable), aligns with your broader objectives (Relevant), and has a defined timeline (Time-bound).

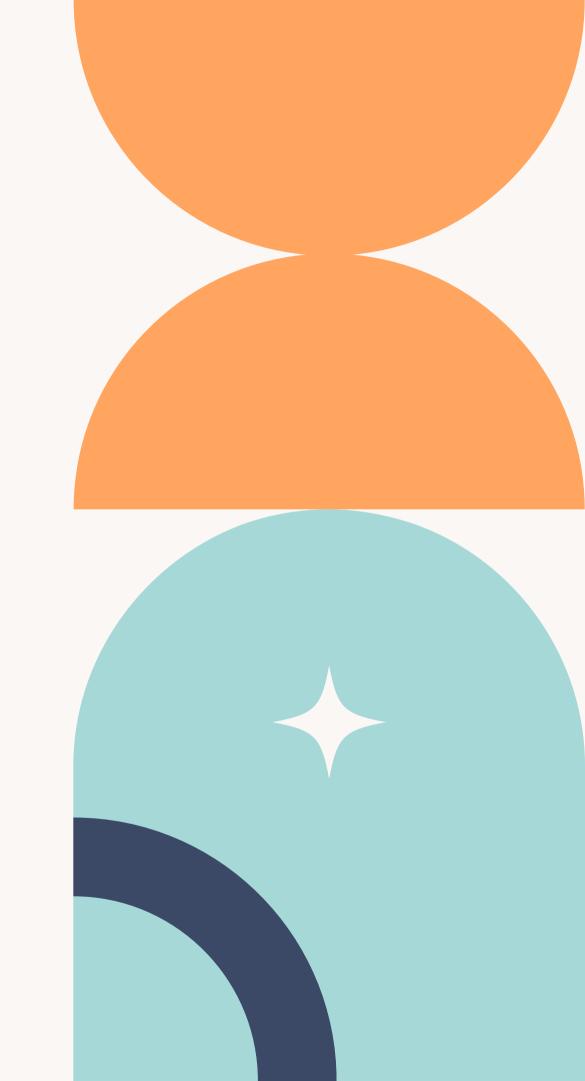

STEP 4 Strategies for Staying Motivated

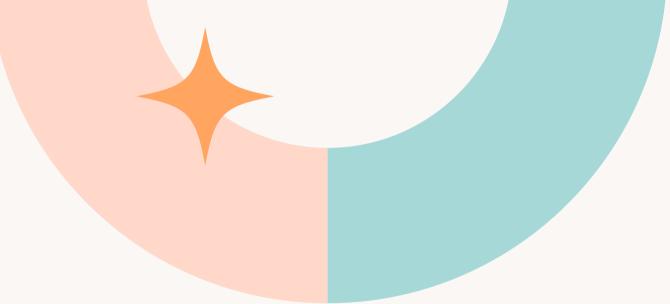
Break larger goals into smaller, manageable tasks to create a sense of progress.
