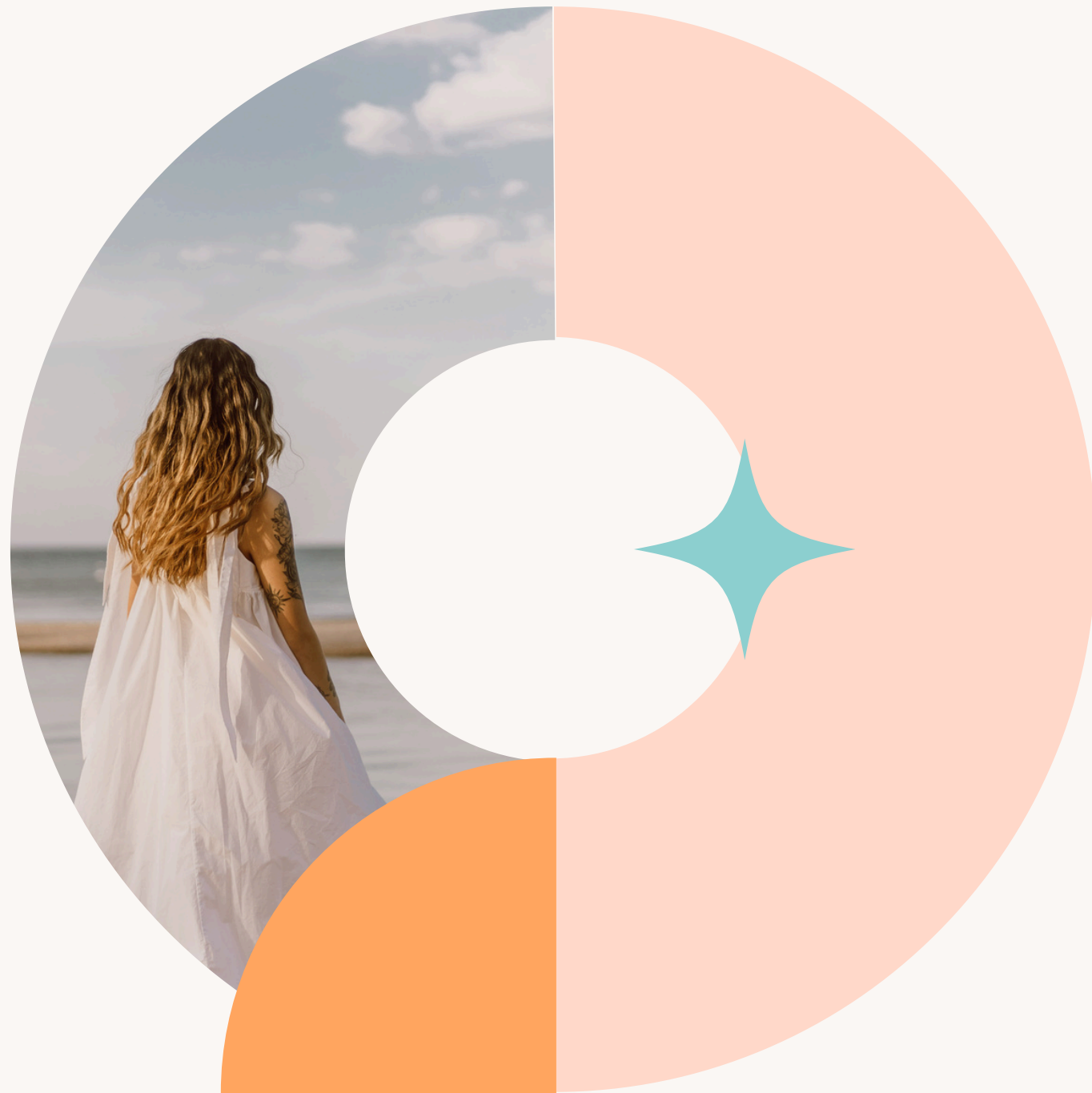
STEP 1

The SMART framework is an effective tool for setting realistic goals.

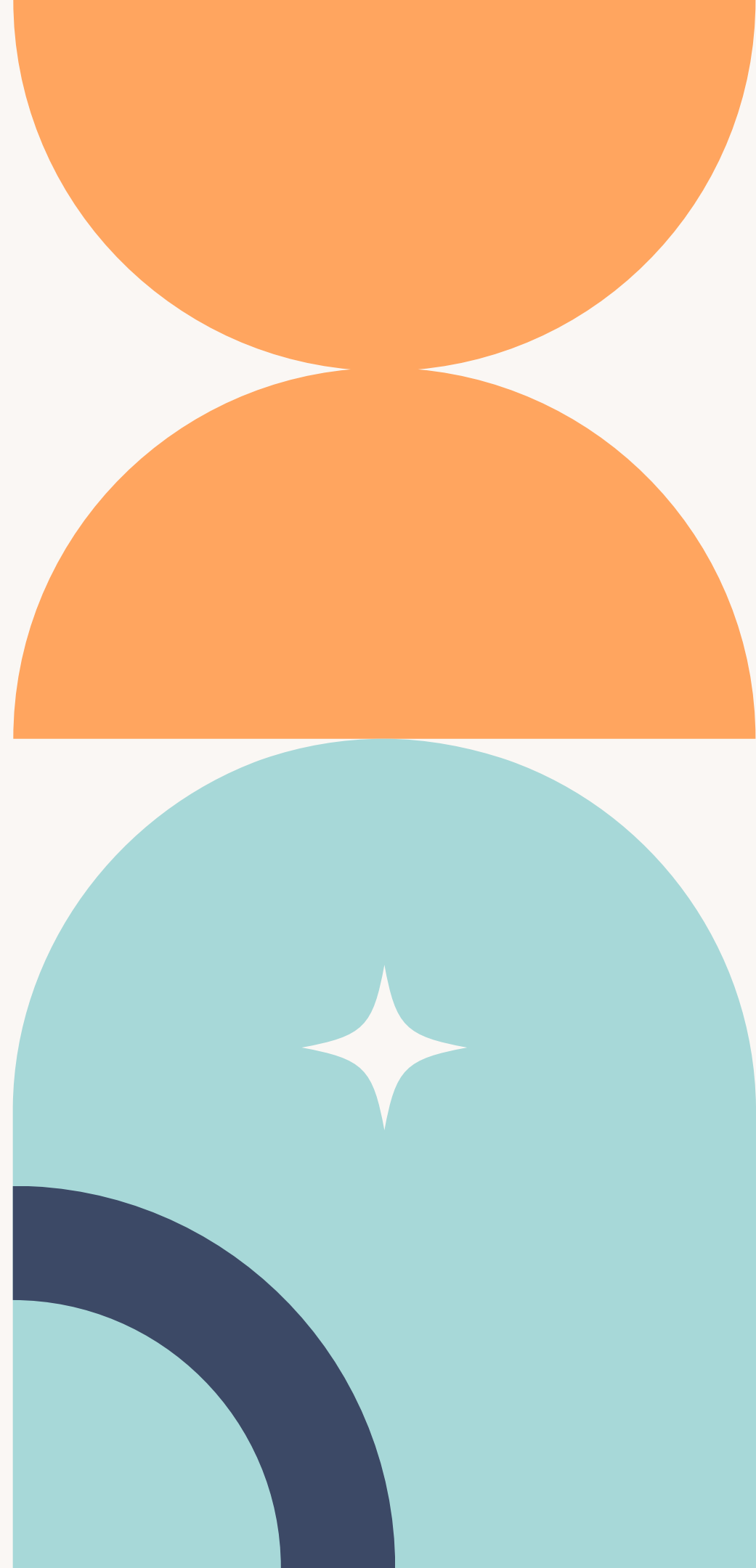
SMART stands for Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Time-bound.

Common Pitfalls to Avoid

- SETTING TOO MANY GOALS AT ONCE
- NEGLECTING TO CONSIDER RESOURCES AND LIMITATIONS
- COMPARING YOURSELF TO OTHERS



STEP 4

Strategies for Staying Motivated

- Break larger goals into smaller, manageable tasks to create a sense of progress.
- Celebrate small victories along the way to keep your motivation high.
- Consider finding an accountability partner or joining a group with similar goals for support and encouragement.
- Regularly remind yourself of the reasons behind your goals to stay connected to your purpose.
